- Event will be run under UCI Regulations and CNZ RTX Technical Regulations
- All NZL riders should hold a valid 2025 domestic race licence (2026 race licences will also be accepted)
- Please note that you are racing in your 2026 age group category

- **Queries**

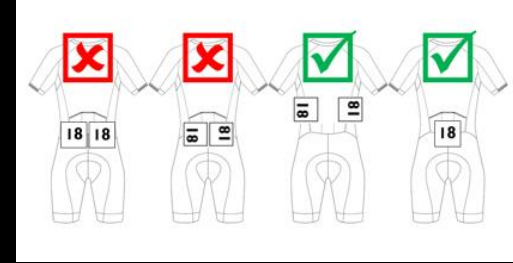

Race Kit and Numbers

Race Kit

Omnium National Championships: Riders must wear their approved Club Colours – skinsuit/jerseys and shorts. Shorts may display sponsors that are detailed on the rider's racing licence. Riders may ride in their Centre Colours if they wish, provided they have clearance from their club to do so. A start may be refused for any incorrectly attired rider.

Madison National Championships: Both riders in each team must be in the same kit. This does not have to be a Club kit, however matching plain kit (or Centre or Club colours) is preferable. Teams must be clearly distinguished from other teams. Team kit/colours must be confirmed along with the team composition at Confirmation of Starters on Tuesday.

Team Pairings

- Teams shall either be New Zealand or International, not mixed.
- Of the 18 teams, half must be New Zealand teams.
- Place getters, regardless of Nationality, shall receive relevant medals and first place New Zealand team will be acknowledged as the Champions for the event.

International Riders

All International riders must hold a valid 2025 International licence issued from their Federation.

All International riders must have written permission from their National Federation in order to compete.

Important Omnium Information

- The National Omnium Championship, when held separately to the National Track Championships, is open to New Zealand and International Riders.
- The events shall be by age category. Where entries are insufficient, the event may be run as an Open Grade.
- International Riders must have an international Licence
- International Riders must have written permission of their National Federation to compete
- At least half the Entries must be New Zealand riders. If Heats are required to meet track limits for the event, all riders proceed to the Finals based only on the results in the Heats
- Placegetters, regardless of nationality, shall receive relevant medals and prize money (if applicable)
- **The first placed New Zealand rider shall be acknowledged as the New Zealand Champions for the event and will receive the National Jersey.**

Important Madison Information

- Teams shall either be New Zealand or International, not mixed.
- Of the 18 teams, at least half must be New Zealand teams.
- Placegetters, regardless of Nationality, shall receive relevant medals.
- The first placed New Zealand team shall be acknowledged as the Champions for the event.

- **Anti Doping**
 - May be present. Ensure you have Photo ID available at all times. Anti doping rooms are on Level 2, follow signs to access.
- **Medals Presentations**
